Tweakwise and Doofinder are solutions for important aspects of a webshop. There are some main differences between the two, though. While Doofinder offers a solution for search and recommendations, Tweakwise also works on product lister pages and has personalization features.

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## DOOFINDER®

### Search

Various types of algorithms  
Autocorrection based on key distance  
Synonyms (Two-way and one-way)  
Redirects based on search term and attribute  
Banners

One method for searching, no algorithm. You assign a weight to properties it should search through.

Boosting rules: boost certain products for specific search terms (rule-based or product-based)

Exclude products from search (for specific search terms or all search queries)

Synonyms (Two-way and one-way)

Redirects based on search term

### Suggestions

Search term suggestions (based on wisdom of the crowd)  
Category suggestions (based on the category name and not the underlying products)  
Attribute suggestions  
Product suggestions

Search phrase suggestions

Category suggestions (based on underlying products)

Product suggestions

### Filtering

Extensive filtering possibilities (settings like automatic sorting of values, etc.)

Basic settings, no difference between various filters

Smart filters

### Sorting

Extensive sorting possibilities, various types of formulas and Google Analytics connectivity to highlight popular products > make a cocktail of various parameters

Sorting based on ascending or descending of a specific property, or multiple
